New Projects => 2

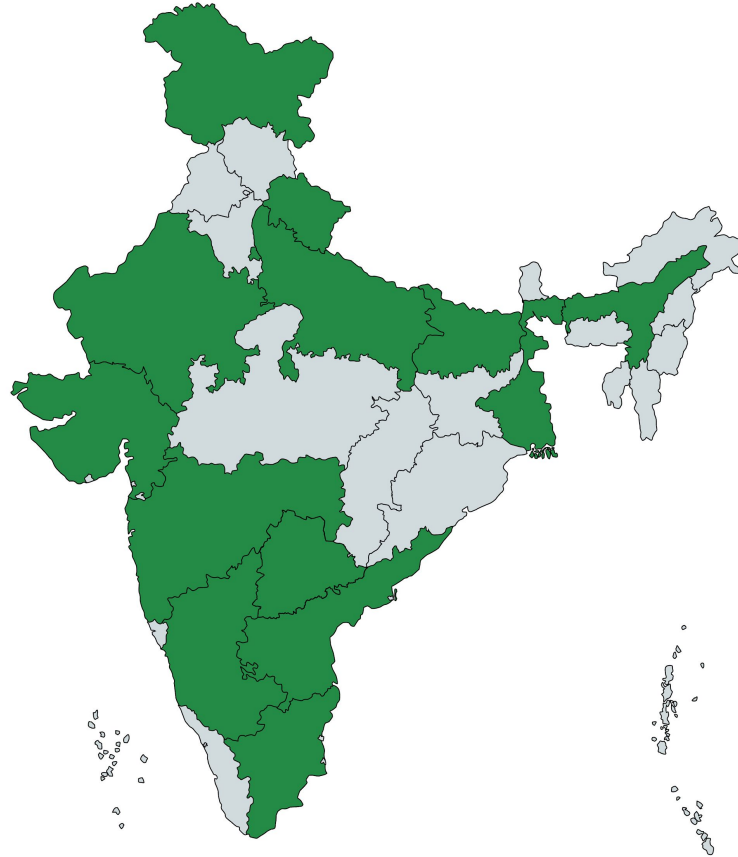
Children Impacted => 6,972

Funds Disbursed [as of 07/31] => \$261,585

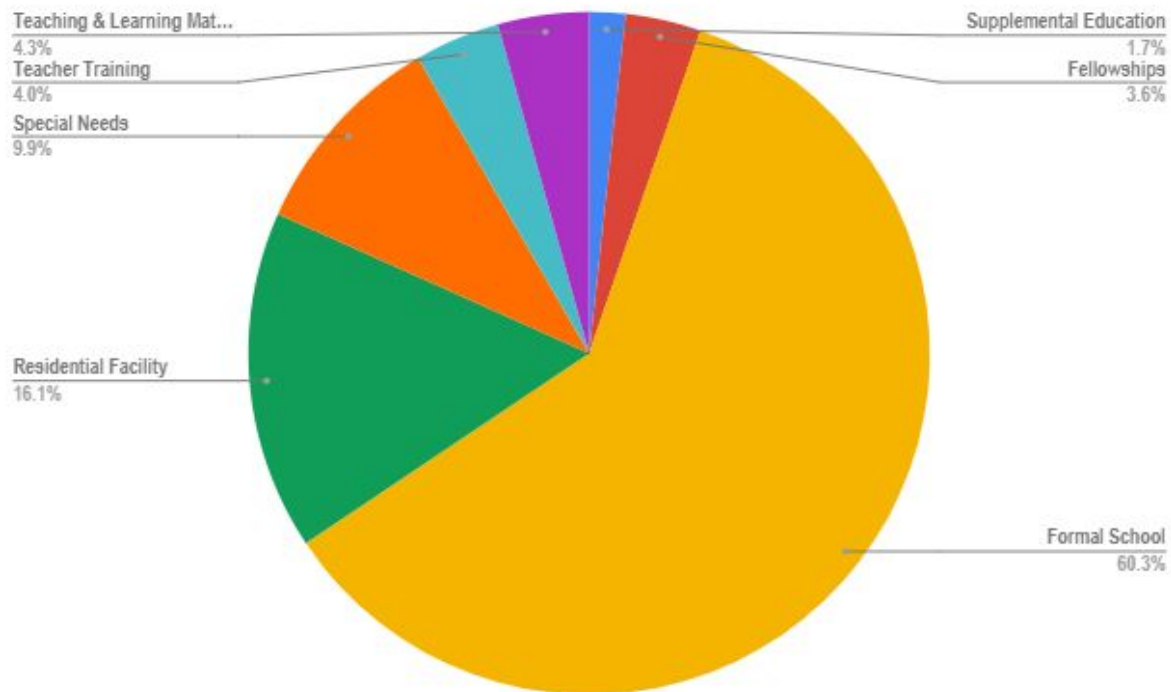
Expected Annual Disbursement => \$580,000

Edu-Impact Contest

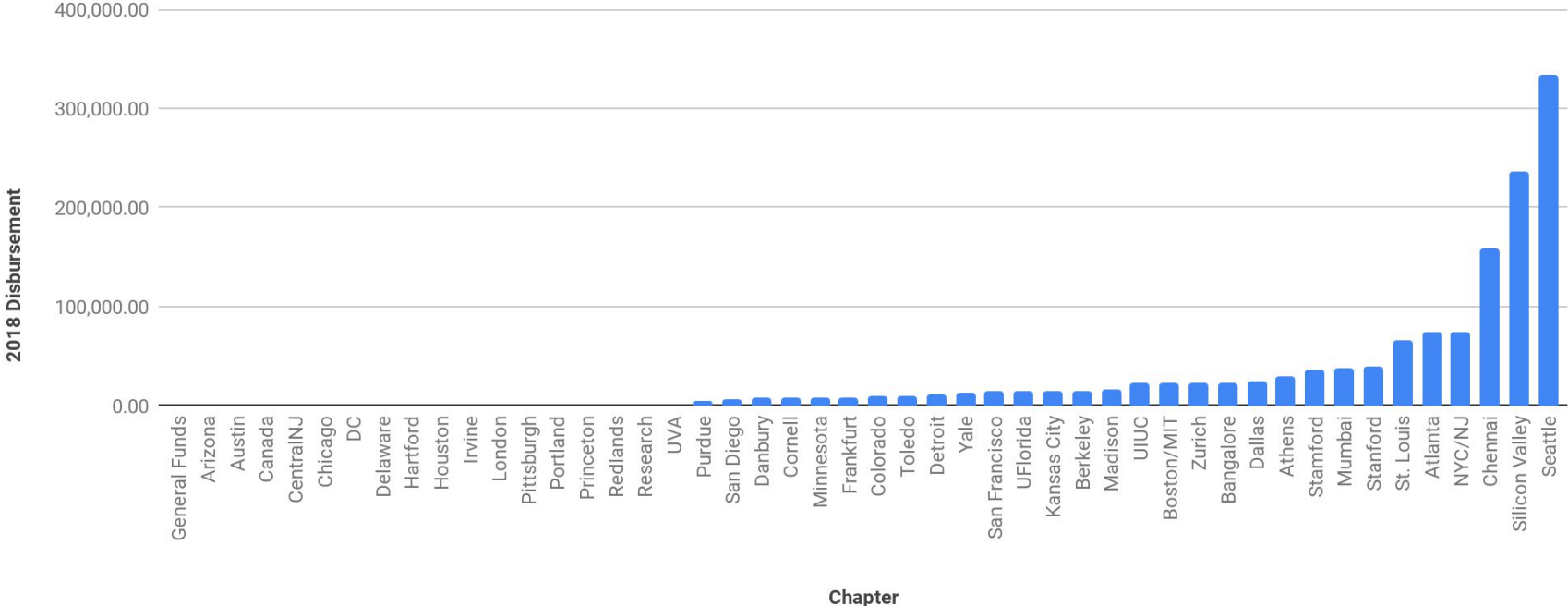
- First of its kind, attracted ~100 entries, INR 20 lakh grant each for two winners
